- 8.3. Phoenix - Casa Grande - Marana Pecan Grove - Tucson - Benson (177 miles/285 km).
- 9.3. Benson - Willcox Twin Lakes - Sulphur Springs Valley: Kansas Settlement Rd & Central Highway- Douglas (196 km).
- 10.3. Douglas - Douglas 9th Ave. - Cochise College - Hyannis Pond - Tombstone - San Pedro House - Sierra Vista (203 km).
- 11.3. Sierra Vista - Palominas Rd. - San Pedro River - Ramsey Canyon - Sierra Vista - Sonoita - Patagonia (196 km).
- 12.3. Patagonia area: Patons', Sonoita Creek Preserve, Patagonia Lake (71 km).
- 13.3. Patagonia - Kino Springs - Nogales - MEXICO, Nogales - Nogales Wastewater Treatment Plant- Green Valley - Tucson (223 km).

27.3. Los Angeles, Venice - International Airport. A total of 3995 miles/6428 km driven.  
Flights Los Angeles - New York 8.00 - 16.00 (3952 km), New York - Helsinki 17.55/19.00 -

28.3. -9.30. Flight Helsinki - Ivalo 11.30 - 13.00.

Flight Helsinki - Phoenix/Los Angeles - Helsinki cost FIM 4435,-(USD 850)per person. Car hire, class F, Mercury Sable -97 (19218 miles in the odometer), FIM 5085,- (USD 975) for three weeks. Lodging mostly in chain motels (mainly "Motel 6"), USD 37 - 80 for a double.

**Common Loon** *Gavia immer* CA: 50 at Morro Bay on 24th and 1 at Ventura harbour on 25.3.

**Red-throated Loon** *Gavia stellata* CA: 1 in winter plumage at Morro Bay on 24.3.

**Western Grebe** *Aechmophorus occidentalis* CA: 3 at Morro Bay on 24th and 2 at Ventura harbour on 25.3.

**Horned Grebe** *Podiceps auritus* CA: 2 at Morro Bay on 24.3.

**Eared Grebe** *Podiceps nigricollis* AZ: 3 at Willcox Twin Lakes on 9th and 17.3., 100 at Patagonia Lake on 12.3. and 2 at Picacho Reservoir on 20.3.

**Pied-billed Grebe** *Podilymbus podiceps* AZ: 1 at Willcox Twin Lakes on 9th, 2 at Patagonia Lake on 12th, 3 at Kino Springs on 13th and 3 at Picacho Reservoir on 20.3.

**Brown Pelican** *Pelecanus occidentalis* CA: 30 at Morro Bay and 50 at Margo Dodd Park, Shell Beach on 24.3.. 1 in a channel at Venice, Los Angeles on 25.3.

**Olivaceous Cormorant** *Phalacrocorax olivaceus* AZ: 4 at Patagonia Lake on 12.3.

**Double-crested Cormorant** *Phalacrocorax auritus* AZ: 10 at Patagonia Lake on 12th, 1 at Kino Springs on 13th, 3 at Picacho Reservoir on 20.3.. CA: 15 at Morro Bay and 15 at Shell Beach on 24th and 30 at Ventura harbour on 25.3.

**Brandt's Cormorant** *Phalacrocorax penicillatus* CA: 1 at Margo Dodd Park, Shell Beach on 24.3.

**Pelagic Cormorant** *Phalacrocorax pelagicus* CA: 15 at Morro Bay on 24.3.

**Black-crowned Night-Heron** *Nycticorax nycticorax* CA: 2 roosting (Marina) and 1 flying at Morro Bay on 24.3.

**Green-backed Heron** *Butorides striatus* CA: 1 adult in the moat of Disneyland "Sleeping Beauty Castle", Anaheim on 26.3.

**Snowy Egret** *Egretta thula* AZ: 1 at Picacho Reservoir on 20.3.. CA: 5 at Morro Bay on 24th and 3 Venice, Los Angeles on 25.3.

**Great Egret** *Casmerodius albus* AZ: 1 at Picacho Reservoir on 20.3..CA: 5 at Morro Bay and 2 in fields south of Morro Bay on 24th, 8 at Mugu Lagoon on 25.3.

**Great Blue Heron** *Ardea herodias* AZ: seen on six days, max. 20 at nests in Patagonia on 12.3.. CA: 3 at Lake Isabella on 23rd and 1 at Morro Bay 24.3.

**White-faced Ibis** *Plegadis chihi* CA: 15 in fields near Mugu Lagoon (Las Posas Road) on 25.3.

**Sandhill Crane** *Grus canadensis* AZ: flocks of 60 circling on 9th and 160 flying on 17.3. at Willcox Twin Lakes.

**Brant** *Branta bernicla* CA: in all 1200 in marsh and tidal flats near Marina and 50 at harbour and near Morro Rock at Morro Bay on 24.3.

**Mallard** *Anas platyrhynchos* AZ: 1-3 birds seen on four days and additionally **Mexican Duck** 1 pair at Cochise College near Douglas on 18th and 3 birds at Agua Caliente Park, Tucson, on 19.3..CA: Mallards: 10 Morro Bay area 24th and 10 Ventura harbour and Mugu Lagoon on 25.3.

**Gadwall** *Anas strepera* AZ: fairly common, max 30 at Willcox Twin Lakes on 9th, additionally 2-6 birds seen on four days. CA: 1 pair at Mugu Lagoon on 25.3.

**Green-winged Teal** *Anas crecca carolinensis* AZ: fairly common, max 30 at Willcox Twin Lakes on 9th and 30 at Hyannis Pond/ Whitewater Draw Wildlife Area on 18.3..

**American Wigeon** *Anas americana* AZ: fairly common, max 500 grazing on Kino Springs Golf Course on 13th, 300 at Willcox Twin Lakes on 17th and 200 at Hyannis Pond on 18.3.. CA: 8 at Morro Bay 24.3.

**Northern Pintail** *Anas acuta* AZ: 1 male at Willcox Twin Lakes on 9th and 1 near Arizona City on 15.3.

**Northern Shoveler** *Anas clypeata* AZ: fairly common, max 400 at Willcox Twin Lakes on 17th - 300 counted on 9.3. there, 50 at Hyannis Pond on 18.3.

**Blue-winged Teal** *Anas discors* AZ: 1 male at Willcox Twin Lakes on 9th and 17.3.

**Cinnamon Teal** *Anas cyanoptera* AZ: 10 at Willcox Twin Lakes on 9th and 30 there on 17.3.. 3 at Whitewater on 18.3.. UT: 3 males between Mt.Carmel Junction and Zion National Park on 23.3.

**Ruddy Duck** *Oxyura jamaicensis* AZ: fairly common, max at Willcox Twin Lakes 50 on 9th and 17.3..40 at Patagonia Lake on 12.3., 1-15 elsewhere on four other days.

**Wood Duck** *Aix sponsa* AZ: 10 at Agua Caliente Park, Tucson, on 19.3.

**Canvasback** *Aythya valisineria* AZ: 1 male 6 fem. at Nogales Wastewater Treatment Plant on 13th and 1 at Willcox Twin Lakes on 17.3.

**Redhead** *Aythya americana* AZ: 1 male at Willcox Twin Lakes on 9th, 10 at Patagonia Lake on 12th and 1 male at Nogales Wastewater Treatment Plant on 13.3.

**Ring-necked Duck** *Aythya collaris* AZ: 3 at Patagonia Lake on 12th, 230 at Nogales Wastewater Treatment Plant on 13th and 60 at Agua Caliente Park, Tucson on 19.3.. CA: 1 pair at Lake Kaweah on 23.3.

**Lesser Scaup** *Aythya affinis* AZ: 10 on 9th and 50 on 17.3. at Willcox Twin Lakes. 1 male at Patagonia Lake on 12.3..CA: 1 at Lake Kaweah on 23.3.

**Surf Scoter** *Melanitta perspicillata* CA: 130 at Morro Bay and 30 at Shell Beach on 24th, 30 at Ventura harbour on 25.3.

**Bufflehead** *Bucephala albeola* AZ: 2 males 1 fem. at Willcox Twin Lakes on 9th and 1 there on 17.3., 2 males 1 fem. at Patagonia Lake on 12.3.

**Common Merganser** *Mergus merganser* AZ: 2 fem. at Willcox Twin Lakes on 9th and 14 at Patagonia Lake on 12.3.

**Red-breasted Merganser** *Mergus serrator* CA: 3 males at Morro Bay on 24th and 2 fem. at Ventura harbour on 25.3.

**American Coot** *Fulica americana* AZ: fairly common, max 200 at Willcox Twin Lakes on 17th and 150 there on 9.3. 2-100 seen at other localities on five days. CA: 2 at Lake Kaweah on 23rd and 3 at Ventura harbour on 25.3.

**Black Oystercatcher** *Haematopus bachmani* CA: 1 at Margo Dodd Park, Shell Beach on 24.3.

**American Avocet** *Recurvirostra americana* AZ: 10 at Hyannis Pond on 18.3.. CA: 250 at Mugu Lagoon on 25.3.

**Black-necked Stilt** *Himantopus mexicanus* CA: 10 in fields near Mugu Lagoon on 25.3.

**Killdeer** *Charadrius vociferus* AZ: fairly common, max 45 south of Arizona City on 20th, 30 there on 15th and 40 at Willcox Twin Lakes on 17.3., 3-15 ind. seen on five days elsewhere. CA: 3 in fields near Mugu Lagoon on 25.3.

**Mountain Plover** *Charadrius montanus* AZ: 15 in fields at "Western Sod", Green Reservoir Rd., south of Arizona City at 12.15 o'clock on 20.3., found after two hours hard searching and a tentative four hour visit on 15th.

**Black-bellied Plover** *Pluvialis squatarola* CA: 10 in fields near Mugu Lagoon on 25.3.

**Lesser Golden Plover** *Pluvialis dominica* CA: 1 Mugu Lagoon and 20 in fields near Mugu Lagoon on 25.3.

**Marbled Godwit** *Limosa fedoa* CA: 250 at Morro Bay on 24th and 30 Mugu Lagoon on 25.3.

**Whimbrel** *Numenius phaeopus* CA: 1 on the beach near Ventura harbour on 25.3.

**Long-billed Curlew** *Numenius americanus* AZ: 1 in fields at Marana Pecan Grove on 15th, 26 near and 65 at Hyannis Pond on 18th and 1 at "Western Sod", south of Arizona City on 20.3.. CA: 70 at Morro Bay on 24.3.

**Willet** *Catoptrophorus semipalmatus* CA: 40 at Morro Bay on 24th and 30 at Mugu Lagoon 25.3.

**Greater Yellowlegs** *Tringa melanoleuca* AZ: 1 at Hyannis Pond on 18th and 1 near Marana Pecan Grove on 20.3.

**Spotted Sandpiper** *Actitis macularia* CA: 1 at Morro Bay Marina on 24.3.

**Long-billed Dowitcher** *Limnodromus scolopaceus* AZ: 7 at Hyannis Pond on 18.3.

**Dowitcher sp.** *Limnodromus griseus/scolopaceus* CA: 25 at Mugu Lagoon, 30 in fields near Mugu Lagoon and 20 in a channel at Venice, Los Angeles on 25.3.

**Common Snipe** *Gallinago gallinago delicata* AZ: 1 at Willcox Twin Lakes on 9th and 3 there on 17.3.. 2 at "Western Sod", south of Arizona City on 20.3.. CA: 1 in fields near Mugu Lagoon on 25.3.

**Dunlin** *Calidris alpina* CA: 10 in fields near Mugu Lagoon on 25.3.

**Least Sandpiper** *Calidris minutilla* AZ: 20 at "Western Sod", south of Arizona City on 15th and 15 there on 20.3.. 15 at Hyannis Pond on 18.3.. CA: 10 in fields near Mugu Lagoon and 8 in a channel at Venice, Los Angeles on 25.3.

**Pectoral Sandpiper** *Calidris melanotos* AZ: 1 seen on two occasions at "Western Sod", south of Arizona City on 20.3.. Description: standing in a field with Least Sandpipers; Dunlin-sized, legs longer and pale-coloured, shortish dark bill, streaked breast.

**Heermann's Gull** *Larus heermanni* CA: 15 1st w at Morro Bay on 24th and 4 1st w at Ventura harbour on 25.3.

**Bonaparte's Gull** *Larus philadelphia* CA: 100 in and over the fields near Mugu Lagoon on 25.3.

**Ring-billed Gull** *Larus delawarensis* AZ: 5 flying north at Willcox on 18.3..CA: 30 at Isabella Reservoir, near Kernville on 23rd, 3 at Morro Bay on 24th and 200 in and over the fields near Mugu Lagoon on 25.3.

**Mew Gull** *Larus canus* CA: 2 2nd w at Morro Bay on 24.3.

**Herring Gull** *Larus argentatus* CA: 20 at Disneyland parking area, Anaheim on 26.3.

**California Gull** *Larus californicus* CA: 10 at Morro Bay and 20 at Shell Beach on 24th, 60 flying west at Mugu Lagoon on 25.3.

**Western Gull** *Larus occidentalis* CA: 180 at Morro Bay and 40 at Shell Beach on 24th, 50 at Ventura harbour on 25.3.

**Glaucous-winged Gull** *Larus glaucescens* CA: 1 2nd w at Morro Rock on 24.3.

**Black-legged Kittiwake** *Rissa tridactyla* CA: 2 winter adults flying north at ca.15 o'clock at Margo Dodd Park on 24.3.

**Forster's Tern** *Sterna forsteri* CA: 1 winter ad 2 transition-plumaged ad at a channel at Venice, Los Angeles on 25.3.

**Royal Tern** *Sterna maxima* CA: 3 flying west at Mugu Lagoon on 25.3.

**Caspian Tern** *Sterna caspia* CA: 5 at Morro Bay on 24.3.

**Turkey Vulture** *Cathartes aura* Fairly common, AZ: max 31 at Portal, Chiricahua Mts on 17.3., elsewhere seen 1- 25 birds on eight days. CA: 13 near Kernville and 19+34 on the west side of Sierra Nevada between Kernville and Sequoia National Park on 23rd, 11+10+15 between Paso Robles - Morro Bay - Shell Beach on 24.3.

**Black Vulture** *Coragyps atratus* AZ: 20 in Santa Cruz Valley, north of Nogales on 13.3.

**California Condor** *Gymnogyps californianus* CA: 5 at feeding station near House Rock, Vermilion Cliffs on 22.3.

**Golden Eagle** *Aquila chrysaetos* AZ: 4 birds seen 14.-17.3. , one on each day, 1 at Florida Canyon Trail, 1 ad at south of Arizona City, 1 ad in Altar Valley and 1 at Portal . NM: 1 2nd cal at Rodeo on 17.3.. CA: 1 near Alta Sierra, Greenhorn Mts on 23.3.

**Bald Eagle** *Haliaeetus leucocephalus* AZ: 1 ad and 1 immature at Hyannis Pond on 18.3.

**Northern Harrier** *Circus cyaneus* AZ: fairly common, max 10 in Sulphur Springs Valley on 9.3., 1-8 (37 in all) seen on nine days additionally.

**Sharp-shinned Hawk** *Accipiter striatus* AZ: 1-2 seen on six days, 7 in all.

**Cooper's Hawk** *Accipiter cooperii* AZ: 1 Sulphur Springs Valley on 9th, 2 at Patagonia on 12th and 1 at Marana Pecan Grove on 15.3.

**Northern Goshawk** *Accipiter gentilis* AZ: 1 east of Jakob Lake on 22.3.

**Red-shouldered Hawk** *Buteo lineatus* CA: 1 at Sequoia National Park on 23rd and 1 near Morro Bay on 24.3.

**Red-tailed Hawk** *Buteo jamaicensis* Common, AZ: seen every day 8.-21.3., 3-20 on 14 days (total 138), UT: 5 at Hurricane on 22.3., CA: 3 near Kernville and 7 on west side of Sierra Nevada on 23rd and 2 near Morro Bay on 24.3.

**Swainson's Hawk** *Buteo swainsoni* AZ: 1 intermediate phase perched on a roadside pole between Friendly Corners and Eloy on 20.3.

**Ferruginous Hawk** *Buteo regalis* AZ: 1 in field between Suninzona and Elfrida on 9th, 1 at "Western Sod", south of Arizona City on 15th and 1 near Pinal Airpark on 20.3.

**Harris' Hawk** *Parabuteo unicinctus* AZ: 4 east of Sells on 16th, 1 perched on a pole at "Speedway 9350", and 1 "Soldier Tr. 3000" in Tucson on 19th, 4 at Picacho Reservoir on 20.3.

**American Kestrel** *Falco sparverius* AZ: common, seen almost daily, 1-12 birds on 12 days, 65 in all. CA: 2 in Morro Bay area 24.3.

**Merlin** *Falco columbarius* AZ: 1 female at Papago Springs Estate, Sonoita on 11th and 1 near Phoenix Airport on 21.3.

**Scaled Quail** *Callipepla squamata* AZ: 2 at Green Valley on 13.3.

**Gambel's Quail** *Callipepla gambelii* AZ: fairly common, max 30 in a garden along 9th Ave, Douglas on 10.3.. 2-22 (total 59) birds seen on other eight days.

**Mountain Quail** *Oreortyx pictus* CA: 1 at Sequoia National Park on 23.3.

**Rock Dove** *Columba livia* Common, AZ: 8.-21.3. 5-50 seen every day on 14 days, 285 counted in all. CA: still more numerous: 20-400 on three days 23.-25.3., 620 in all.

**Mourning Dove** *Zenaida macroura* Common, AZ: 8.-21.3. 52-400 seen every day on 14 days, 1777 in all. CA: 2-50 on three days, 72 in all.

**White-winged Dove** *Zenaida asiatica* AZ: 5 in Douglas on 10th, 1 on 16th and 1 near Ramsey Canyon on 19.3.

**Common Ground-dove** *Columbina passerina* AZ: 3 at Patagonia Sewage Pond and 2 in Patagonia- Sonoita Creek Preserve on 12.3.

**Inca Dove** *Columbina inca* AZ: 31 on 8th, 16 on 15th and 3 on 20.3. at Marana Pecan Grove. 2 at Douglas on 10th and 3 at Arivaca on 16.3.

**Greater Roadrunner** *Geococcyx californianus* AZ: fairly "common"= frequently seen, 1-4 birds on nine days, 18 in all.

**Short-eared Owl** *Asio flammeus* AZ: 1 at Marana Pecan Grove at 13.20 o'clock on 15.3.

**Great Horned Owl** *Bubo virginianus* AZ: 1 at Marana Pecan Grove on 8.3.

**White-throated Swift** *Aeronautes saxatalis* AZ: 2-30 seen on four days, max 30 at Portal on 17.3. CA: four groups, 80 in all, on 23.3.

**Broad-billed Hummingbird** *Cynanthus latirostris* AZ: 6 at Patons', Patagonia and 1 male at Patagonia Lake on 12th, 2 males at Santa Rita Lodge on 14.3.

**Violet-crowned Hummingbird** *Amazilia violiceps* AZ: 1 male at Mendoza Alley and 4 at Patons', Patagonia on 12.3.

**Blue-throated Hummingbird** *Lampornis clemenciae* AZ: 1 male 1 fem. at Ramsey Canyon on 11.3.

**Magnificent Hummingbird** *Eugenes fulgens* AZ: 1 male at Ramsey Canyon on 11th and 1 male + 1 there on 19th, 1 fem. at Santa Rita Lodge on 14.3.. 1 male at Spoffords', Portal and 1 male at SW Research Station on 17.3.

**Black-chinned Hummingbird** *Archilochus alexandri* AZ: 1 male at Patons', Patagonia on 12th and 1 male at San Pedro River on 19.3.. CA: 1 male at Sequoia National Park on 23.3.

**Costa's Hummingbird** *Calypte costae* AZ: 1 male at a Speedway filling station in eastern Tucson on 19.3.



**Anna's Hummingbird** *Calypte anna* AZ: 1 male at Patons', Patagonia on 12th and 1 male at Arizona City on 15.3.. CA: 1 male at Morro Bay Marina on 24.3.

**Broad-tailed Hummingbird** *Selasphorus platycercus* AZ: 1 male at Casa Grande on 8.3.

**Allen's Hummingbird** *Selasphorus sasin* CA: 1 male at Morro Bay Marina on 24.3.

**Belted Kingfisher** *Ceryle alcyon* AZ: 1 at Kino Springs on 13.3.

**Gila Woodpecker** *Melanerpes uropygialis* AZ: fairly common, max 20 on 13.3., majority of which in Kino Springs area, 1-15 birds seen on eight other days.

**Northern Flicker** *Colaptes auratus* AZ: "Red-shafted" form fairly common, 1-10 seen on 11 days. "Gilded" form: a nest found in saguaro and 5 birds seen in Altar Valley on 16.3.. CA: 1 "red-shafted" at Paso Robles on 24.3.

**Red-headed Woodpecker** *Melanerpes erythrocephalus* AZ: 1 at Marana Pecan Grove on 8th and 20.3.

**Acorn Woodpecker** *Melanerpes formicivorus* AZ: fairly common, max 20 at Madera Canyon area on 14.3., 1-4 seen on six other days. CA: 15 Kernville area and westwards and 5 at Sequoia National Park on 23.3.

**Lewis' Woodpecker** *Melanerpes lewis* AZ: 1 at Marana Pecan Grove on 8th and 20.3.

**Red-naped Sapsucker** *Sphyrapicus nuchalis* AZ: 1 at Marana Pecan Grove on 8.3.

**Ladder-backed Woodpecker** *Picoides scalaris* AZ: 1-4 seen on five days, 10 in all.

**Nuttall's Woodpecker** *Picoides nuttallii* CA: 1 at "General Sherman Tree", Sequoia National Park on 23.3.

**Strickland's Woodpecker** *Picoides stricklandi* AZ: 5 at Ramsey Canyon on 11th and 1 in Cave Creek Canyon on 17.3.

**Pileated Woodpecker** *Dryocopus pileatus* CA: 1 at Sequoia National Park on 23.3.

**Western Kingbird** *Tyrannus verticalis* AZ: 1 at Kino Springs on 13.3..CA: 3 along the road on west slopes of Sierra Nevada between Kernville and California Hot Springs on 23.3.

**Cassin's Kingbird** *Tyrannus vociferans* AZ: 1 at Tubac area on 13.3.

**Black Phoebe** *Sayornis nigricans* AZ: 1-5 seen on eight days, 15 in all.

**Say's Phoebe** *Sayornis saya* AZ: fairly common, 1-8 seen on 11 days, 40 in all.

**Vermilion Flycatcher** *Pyrocephalus rubinus* AZ: fairly common, max 19 on 13th in southern Santa Cruz River Valley. 1-10 seen on nine other days. Total number 61.

**Gray Flycatcher** *Empidonax wrightii* AZ: 1 at Patagonia Sewage Pond on 12.3.

**Hammond's Flycatcher** *Empidonax hammondi* AZ: 1 at Marana Pecan Grove on 8.3.

**Horned Lark** *Eremohila alpestris* AZ: 20- 55 seen on four days 8.-20.3., max 50 near "Western Sod", south of Arizona City on 15.3.. CA: 1 near Kernville on 23.3.

**Tree Swallow** *Tachycineta bicolor* AZ: 4 at Kino Springs on 13th, 2 at Hyannis Pond on 18.3.. CA: 3 on 23rd and 3 on 24.3. plus at Paso Robles 200 Swallow sp., most likely this species on 24.3.

**Northern Rough-winged Swallow** *Stelgidopteryx serripennis* AZ: 1-9 seen on five days 13.-20.3., max 9 at Picacho Reservoir on 20.3.. CA: 2 on 23rd and 1 on 24.3.

**Cliff Swallow** *Hirundo pyrrhonota* CA: 10 over fields near Mugu Lagoon on 25.3.

**Barn Swallow** *Hirundo rustica* AZ: 2 at Kino Springs on 13.3.. CA: 1 on 24th, 10 near Mugu Lagoon on 25.3.

**Scrub Jay** *Aphelocoma coerulescens* CA: a total of 18 on western slopes of Sierra Nevada between Kernville and Sequoia National Park on 23.3.

**Gray-breasted Jay** *Aphelocoma ultramarina* AZ: easy to find in SE mountain forests, 6-35 seen on six days.

**Pinyon Jay** *Gymnorhinus cyanocephalus* AZ: 3 near House Rock, Vermilion Cliffs on 22.3.

**Steller's Jay** *Cyanocitta stelleri* AZ: 2 in Madera Canyon on 14 th and 3 at Chiricahua National Monument on 18.3..CA: 1 near Paso Robles on 24.3.

**American Crow** *Corvus brachyrhynchos* CA: 5 -20 seen daily on 23.-25.3.

**Chihuahuan Raven** *Corvus cryptoleucus* AZ: 2- 30 identified on six days.

**Common Raven** *Corvus corax* Fairly common, AZ: max 60 at House Rock, Vermilion Cliffs on 22.3., 1- 35 identified on additional eight days. CA: 50 on 23rd, 20 on 24.3.

**Plain Titmouse** *Parus inornatus* CA: 3 at Sequoia National Park on 23.3.

**Bridled Titmouse** *Parus wollweberi* AZ: 1 - 15 seen on six days.

**Mexican Chickadee** *Parus sclateri* AZ: 3 along the road between SW Research Station and Bear Spring, Chiricahuas on 17.3.

**Mountain Chickadee** *Parus gambeli* CA: 1 at Sequoia National Park on 23.3.

**Verdin** *Auriparus flaviceps* AZ: 1- 2 seen on five days, CA: 1 at Furnace Creek, Death Valley on 23.3.

**Bushtit** *Psaltiparus minimus* CA: 3 along the road between Kernville and California Hot Springs on 23rd, 1 at Morro Bay on 24.3.

**White-breasted Nuthatch** *Sitta carolinensis* AZ: 1- 10 on four days, 23 in all.

**House Wren** *Troglodytes aedon* AZ: 1 at Marana Pecan Grove on 20.3.

**Bewick's Wren** *Thryomanes bewickii* AZ: 1- 6 on four days, total number 15.

**Marsh Wren** *Cistothorus palustris* AZ: 1- 3 on three days, 6 in all.

**Canyon Wren** *Catherpes mexicanus* AZ: 1 along a mountain road near Patagonia - Sonoita Creek Preserve on 12.3., CA: 2 at Morro Rock on 24.3.

**Rock Wren** *Salpinctes obsoletus* AZ: 1 between Gleeson and Tombstone on 10.3..CA: 1 between Death Valley and Owens Lake on 23.3.

**Cactus Wren** *Campylorhynchus brunneicapillus* AZ: fairly common, 1- 20 seen on 10 days, 60 in all.

**Ruby-crowned Kinglet** *Regulus calendula* AZ: fairly common, 1- 10 seen on 10 days, CA: 5 on 23.3.

**Blue-gray Gnatcatcher** *Polioptila caerulea* AZ: 1 near Madera Canyon Road and 3 at Florida Canyon Trail on 14th, 2 at Picacho Reservoir on 20.3.

**Black-tailed Gnatcatcher** *Polioptila melanura* AZ: 1 at Green Valley on 13.3.

**Western Bluebird** *Sialia mexicana* AZ: 1 at Sonoita on 11th, 1 at Kino Springs on 13th and 2 near House Rock, Vermilion Cliffs on 22.3.. CA: 2 between Kernville and California Hot Springs on 23.3.

**Mountain Bluebird** *Sialia currucoides* AZ: 2 males near House Rock, Vermilion Cliffs on 22.3.. CA: 1 female near Kernville on 23.3.

**Townsend's Solitaire** *Myadestes townsendi* CA: 1 on mountains between Kernville and California Hot Springs on 23.3.

**Hermit Trush** *Catharus guttatus* AZ: 2 Florida Canyon Road on 14th, 1 in Cave Creek Canyon on 17th and 1 on 19.3.

**American Robin** *Turdus migratorius* AZ: 30 Florida Canyon Road on 14th, 12 Portal - Cave Creek Canyon on 17.3.. CA: 2 near Kernville and 3 at Sequoia National Park on 23.3.

**Loggerhead Shrike** *Lanius ludovicianus* AZ: common, 2- 30 seen on 12 days, 133 in all. CA: 2 seen on 23rd, 2 on 24.3.

**Northern Mockingbird** *Mimus polyglottos* AZ: fairly common, 1- 15 seen on 10 days, 39 in all. CA: 2 seen on 23rd, 1 on 24.3.

**Curve-billed Trasher** *Toxostoma curvirostre* AZ: fairly common, 1- 8 seen on 8 days, 30 in all.

**Bendire's Trasher** *Toxostoma bendirei* AZ: 2 at Kansas Settlement Road on 9th, 2 south of Arizona City on 15th, 2 on 17th, 1 south of Willcox and 1 near Hyannis Pond on 18.3.

**Crissal Trasher** *Toxostoma crissale* AZ: 1+2 at Kansas Settlement Road on 9th and 1 at Picacho Reservoir on 20.3.

**American Pipit** *Anthus rubescens* AZ: common in fields, seen on six days, max 200 near Elfrida on 9.3.. CA: 20 in fields near Mugu Lagoon on 25.3.

**Sprague's Pipit** *Anthus spragueii* AZ: 1 at Papago Springs estate, Sonoita on 11.3.

**Cedar Waxwing** *Bombycilla cedrorum* AZ: 40 at Florida Canyon Road on 14.3.

**Phainopepla** *Phainopepla nitens* AZ: fairly common, 1- 20 seen on seven days, 55 in all.

**European Starling** *Sturnus vulgaris* fairly common, AZ: 1- 50 seen on eight days, CA: 20- 30 on three days.

**Yellow-rumped Warbler** *Dendroica coronata* AZ: fairly common, 1- 6 seen on 11 days. CA: 2 seen on 23rd and 24.3.

**Yellow Warbler** *Dendroica petechia* AZ: 1 male 1 female near San Pedro House on 19.3.

**Common Yellowthroat** *Geothlypis trichas* AZ: 1 male at Marana Pecan Grove on 8.3.

**Painted Redstart** *Myioborus pictus* AZ: 2 on 11th at Ramsey Canyon and 1 there on 19th, 5 at Madera Canyon on 14th and 2 at Spoffords', Portal on 17.3.

**Northern Cardinal** *Cardinalis cardinalis* AZ: 1- 5 seen on seven days, total number 19.

**Pyrrhuloxia** *Cardinalis sinuatus* AZ: 1- 5 seen on eight days, 18 in all.

**Lazuli Bunting** *Passerina amoena* AZ: 1 1st w male at Patons', Patagonia on 12.3.

**Green-tailed Towhee** *Pipilo chlorurus* AZ: 1- 3 seen on seven days, 11 in all.

**Rufous-sided Towhee** *Pipilo erythrophthalmus* AZ: 1 at Florida Canyon Road on 14th and 3 at Portal on 17.3.

**Brown Towhee** *Pipilo fuscus* AZ: fairly common, 3- 10 seen on seven days, total number 40. CA: **California Towhee** 2 between Kernville and California Hot Springs on 23.3.

**Abert's Towhee** *Pipilo aberti* AZ: 6 at Marana Pecan Grove on 8th and 15th and 3 there on 20th. 3 near San Pedro House on 11th and 2 at Picacho Reservoir on 20.3.

**Grasshopper Sparrow** *Ammodramus savannarum* AZ: 1 at Hyannis Pond on 18.3.

**Baird's Sparrow** *Ammodramus bairdii* AZ: 1 at Hyannis Pond on 18.3.

**Vesper Sparrow** *Poocetes gramineus* AZ: fairly common, 1- 20 seen on seven days, max 20 at Kino Springs on 13.3.

**Savannah Sparrow** *Passerculus sandwichensis* AZ: common, 5- 100 seen on 11 days, 85 of which between Willcox and Chiricahua National Monument on 18.3..CA: 2 at Isabella Reservoir on 23.3.

**Song Sparrow** *Melospiza melodia* AZ: 1 near Pinal Airpark on 8th, 5 south of Arizona City on 15.3.

**Lark Sparrow** *Chondestes grammacus* AZ: 2 near Pinal Airpark on 8th, 80 in Santa Cruz Valley, north of Nogales on 13th and 4 at Marana Pecan Grove on 15.3.

**Black-throated Sparrow** *Amphispiza bilineata* AZ: 2 in a garden along 9th Ave, Douglas on 10th, 2 on 14th Madera Canyon area and 1 at Picacho Reservoir on 20.3.. NM:1 pair at Rodeo on 17.3.

**Rufous-winged Sparrow** *Aimophila carpalis* AZ: 5 near Madera Canyon Road on 14.3.

**Rufous-crowned Sparrow** *Aimophila ruficeps* AZ: 2 at Papago Springs estate, Sonoita on 11.3.

**Chipping Sparrow** *Spizella passerina* AZ: fairly common: 1- 100 on seven days, max 100 at Patagonia area on 12.3.

**Brewer's Sparrow** *Spizella breweri* AZ: 2 in a garden along 9th Ave, Douglas on 10th, 3 along Palominas Road, east of Sierra Vista and 5 at Papago Springs estate, Sonoita on 11th, 4 at Kino Springs and 100 at Nogales Wastewater Treatment Plant on 13.3.

**Dark-eyed Junco** *Junco hyemalis* AZ: fairly common, 1- 50 seen on six days, max 50 at Madera Canyon area on 14.3.. A group of 11 there consisted of 6 Gray-headed, 2 White-winged and 1 Slate-colored, 1 Oregon and 1 Oregon pink-sided form. CA: 1 Oregon pink-sided near Kernville on 23.3.

**Yellow-eyed Junco** *Junco phaeonotus* AZ: 6 at Santa Rita Lodge on 14th, 2 in Cave Creek Canyon and 6 at Southwestern Research Station, Chiricahuas on 17.3.

**White-crowned Sparrow** *Zonotrichia leucophrys* AZ: common, 5- 50 seen on 12 days. CA: 5 at Morro Bay 24.3.

**Golden-crowned Sparrow** *Zonotrichia atricapilla* AZ: 1 seen in the hand at Marana Pecan Grove on 20.3.. CA: 6 at Morro Bay marina on 24.3.

**Lincoln's Sparrow** *Melospiza lincolnii* AZ: 1 at Marana Pecan Grove on 8th and 20th, 45 at Patagonia Sewage Pond on 12.3., 1 in Sulphur Springs Valley on 18.3.

**Swamp Sparrow** *Melospiza georgiana* AZ: 3 near Marana Pecan Grove junction on 8th, 4 south of Arizona City on 15th, 1 at Hyannis Pond on 18th and 1 near San Pedro House on 19.3.

**McCown's Longspur** *Calcarius mccownii* CA: 12 in fields south of Pinal Airpark on 8.3.

**Lark Bunting** *Calamospiza melanocorys* AZ: fairly numerous, 7- 300 on six days, max 300 along Kansas Settlement Road on 9.3.

**Eastern Meadowlark** *Sturnella magna* AZ: 1- 50 identified on five days, 5- 40 unidentified Meadowlarks seen on six other days.

**Western Meadowlark** *Sturnella neglecta* AZ: 5 at Cochise College on 10th and 1 south of Arizona City on 15.3.. CA: 1 on 23rd and 1 on 24.3.

**Yellow-headed Blackbird** *Xanthocephalus xanthocephalus* AZ: 500 along Kansas Settlement Road on 9th, 3 at Portal and 200 at Willcox Twin Lakes on 17th, 1400 at Cochise College on 18th and 1 at Marana Pecan Grove on 20.3.

**Red-winged Blackbird** *Agelaius phoeniceus* AZ: common, 2- 1000 on ten days, max 1000 in Sulphur Springs Valley on 9.3.. CA: 1- 50 on 23.- 25.3.

**Brewer's Blackbird** *Euphagus cyanocephalus* AZ: common, 10- 1000 on nine days, max 1000 in Sulphur Springs Valley on 9.3..CA: 2- 70 on 23.- 25.3.

**Brown-headed Cowbird** *Molothrus ater* AZ: 10 at San Pedro House on 10th and 20 there on 19.3.

**Great-tailed Grackle** *Quiscalus mexicanus* AZ: common, 2- 200 seen on 13 days, max 200 in Patagonia area on 12.3.

**Scott's Oriole** *Icterus parisorum* AZ : 1 male at Florida Canyon Trail and 1 1st spring male at Santa Rita Lodge on 14th, 1 male near Spoffords', Portal on 17.3.

**Northern Oriole** *Icterus galbula* AZ: 1 male "**Bullock's Oriole**" at Santa Rita Lodge on 14.3.

**House Sparrow** *Passer domesticus* Common, AZ: 5- 60 seen on 12 days. CA: 10- 10 seen on three days.

**Pine Siskin** *Carduelis pinus* AZ: 2 at Patons', Patagonia on 12th and 50 at Portal on 17.3..CA: 5 at Morro Bay marina on 24.3.

**American Goldfinch** *Carduelis tristis* AZ: 1 at Agua Caliente Park, Tucson on 19.3.

**Lesser Goldfinch** *Carduelis psaltria* AZ: 3 - including a nest-building female - at Marana Pecan Grove on 8th and 1 male there on 20th, 6 in a garden along 9th Ave, Douglas on 10th, 10 at Portal on 17.3..CA: 2 at Furnace Creek, Death Valley on 23.3.

**Cassin's Finch** *Carpodacus cassinii* AZ: fairly common, 1- 8 seen on eight days, max 8 at Portal on 17.3., total number 35.

**House Finch** *Carpodacus mexicanus* AZ: fairly common, 1- 32 seen on seven days, max 17 in a garden along 9th Ave, Douglas on 10.3.

A total of **211 species** seen, 111 of which not in California and 45 not in Arizona.
